

**ORDINANCE 40**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COHASSET, MINNESOTA, AMENDING  
ORDINANCE NO. 15, REGULATING AND REQUIRING A LICENSE FOR THE  
SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND CONDUCT ON LICENSED  
PREMISES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COHASSET, MINNESOTA DOES HEREBY  
AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 15 AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph 4. Definitions is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.4. "3.2 PERCENT MALT LIQUOR" is malt liquor not containing not less than 1/2 of 1 percent alcohol by volume or more than 3.2 percent by weight. (This definition includes so-called "malt coolers" with alcoholic content limits stated herein.) All reference to beer in Ordinance 15 shall be substituted with 3.2 percent malt liquor.

Section 20. Hours and Days of 3.2 Percent Malt Liquor Sales is hereby amended to read as follows:

No sale of 3.2 percent malt liquor may be made between 2:00 A.M. and 8:00 A.M. on the days of Monday through Saturday, nor between 2:00 A.M. and 12:00 Noon on Sunday, provided that an establishment located on land owned by the metropolitan sports commission, or the sports arena for which one or more licenses have been issued under Section 340A.404, Subdivision 2, paragraph (c), may sell 3.2 percent malt liquor between 10:00 A.M. and 12:00 Noon on Sunday on which a sports or other event is scheduled to begin at that location at or before 1:00 P.M. of that day.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication. This Ordinance was passed by the Cohasset City Council on January 11, 2005.
