

ORDINANCE 39

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE ANNUAL
CITY ELECTIONS FOR THE CITY OF COHASSET
IN EVEN YEARS**

The City Council of the City of Cohasset does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I

OPTIONAL CITY ELECTION DATES. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes §205.07 the City Council hereby adopts the optional city election dates allowed under such law, changing the annual city elections from the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, in odd years to the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in even years, which will make the next city election to be held on November 7, 2006.


SECTION II

BIENNIAL ELECTIONS. Beginning with the City election held on November 7, 2006, the City of Cohasset, will from this date forward, hold biennial elections as authorized by Minnesota Statute.
