ORDINANCE NO. EIGHTEEN (18)

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY COUNCIL TO IMPOSE TRUCK RESTRICTIONS AND SEASONAL WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS UPON VARIOUS STREETS AND HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE CITY OF BASS BROOK:

The Council of the City of Bass Brook does hereby ordain as follows:

1. Section 1. TRUCK RESTRICTIONS. The City Council by resolution may designate streets in which travel by commercial vehicles in excess of the posted gross weight is prohibited. A City Street Commissioner or Police shall erect appropriate signs on such streets. No person shall operate a commercial vehicle on such posted streets in violation of the restrictions stated.
2. Section 2. SEASONAL WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS. The City Council may prohibit the operation of vehicles upon any street under its jurisdiction or impose weight restrictions on vehicles to be operated on such street whenever the street, by reasons of deterioration, rain, snow, or other climatic conditions will be seriously damaged or destroyed unless the use of vehicles on the street is prohibited or the permissible weights thereof reduced. The Council shall erect and maintain signs plainly indicating the prohibition or restriction at the City limit lines. No person shall operate a vehicle on a posted street in violation of the prohibition or restriction, except that travel on certain streets may be allowed by prior permit of the City Council.
3. Section 3. VIOLATION. A violation of the above Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor.

The above Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication.
