**Cohasset residents only, no businesses.** Attendants may verify taxpayer and/or resident status by checking driver's licenses, or property tax statements or utility bills.

City staff will be available to assist in unloading material into containers. Residents that are physically unable to bring their items to the Community Center can arrange for pick-up by calling City Hall at 328-6225, ext. 15.

## **ITASCA COUNTY ELECTRONICS RECYCLING UPDATE**

The following Itasca County sites accept electronics during normal hours of operation:

- Cohasset Transfer Station (C.R. #62)
- Bray Lake Canister Site (C.R. #56)
- Spring Lake Canister Site (C.R. #4)

Effective March 1st, 2009, free electronics drop-off will be limited to computer monitors & TV's with screens greater than 7 inches. All other electronic devices will be charged household garbage rates of \$2.00 per 33 gallon bag or equivalent.

Electronic business waste is not included – coupon payment required.
